

## Construction Update E MONTPELIER Route 14 Bridge – week of October 2, 2017

Hello,

After several weeks of reconstruction, US Route 2 has received a base layer of pavement to provide a smooth traveling surface through the winter. The final paving and line striping will be done when the new bridge is opened next fall – in 2018.

During the week of October 2, the contractor will pour concrete for the new sidewalk and curbing along US 2. This work will occur outside of the roadway and is not expected to affect traffic.

CCS Constructors has installed a crane pad next to the Winooski River and will continue to drive piles for the temporary bridge foundation next week.

The posted speed limit will remain 25 mph as the area remains a construction zone. Please watch for flaggers who will assist motorists traveling through the work area.

It is illegal in Vermont to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.
