

Construction Update E MONTPELIER Route 14 Bridge – week of September 18, 2017

Hello,

Next week the contractor for the E Montpelier VT 14 Bridge Project will focus on two areas:

- Along the west side of US Route 2, the contractor will continue to prepare for work for the paving of the extra lane and the installation of new concrete curb & sidewalk. Mid-week during the evening hours the contractor will pave the new lanes located near the intersection of US 2 and VT 14.
- Next to the Winooski River, near VT 14, the contractor will begin installing piles needed for constructing the foundation for the temporary bridge that will be used in 2018.

About 1,400 feet south of the construction zone, in the coned off area in front of guardrail on US 2 south of the East Montpelier Home Center, the State's boring crew may be on site for 2-3 days next week during non-peak hours in the day time (9:00 AM – 3:00 PM) to take borings of a slide area next to the roadway that is needed to design a repair of the slide. This work is not associated with the VT 14 Bridge Project.

The bridge project construction crew will work days and outside of the travel lanes. There may be occasional delay when trucks need to move in and out of the work zone.

The posted speed limit will remain 25 mph as the area remains a construction zone.

It is illegal in Vermont to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.
