

Construction Update E MONTPELIER Route 14 Bridge – week of August 7, 2017

Hello,

Next week, starting the evening of Sunday, July 30, the reconstruction of US 2 will begin in E Montpelier village. The contractor will excavate Route 2, remove the concrete slab underlying the road, build a new sub-base and restore the pavement. The contractor will start work on the west (Montpelier) end of the project.

About 900 feet of Route 2 will be rebuilt. The contractor expects the work will take 10-14 days and will be done at night, between 7 PM and 7 AM, Sunday through Thursday. For the next few weeks motorists will be driving on a rough, non-paved surface so are advised to reduce speeds within the construction zone.

Once the concrete slab removal has been completed, the contractor plans to switch to daytime work during non-peak travel hours.

Please slow down while driving through the work zone and remember that it is illegal in Vermont to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.
