

VT 14 Bridge Project Construction Update – week of October 10-14, 2016

Next week, October 10-14, the contractor will begin to install drainage culverts (without excavation of roadway) under US 2 near the junction of VT 14 in E Montpelier. There will be minimal stoppage of traffic between 9 AM and 3 PM, mostly to get equipment and material to the site and to remove excavation material. On Tuesday, October 11 to complete installation of utility conduits, and possibly a second night later in the week, there will be alternating traffic throughout the night.

This week's excavation of US 2 for a drainage culvert removed pavement from the road and it is currently covered with a gravel surface. There is a second area near the intersection of VT 14 on the eastbound that is also a gravel surface. As a result, VTrans requests motorists strictly observe the 25 mph posted speed limit through E Montpelier village.
