

Hello,

Next week (May 7-11) CCS Constructors, INC, will continue with three different work activities to advance the construction of a new VT 14 Bridge over the Winooski River in E Montpelier.

- A crane located on the VT 14 side of the river will drill shafts that will support the new bridge.
- Work building a causeway on the south side of the river will continue. This causeway will provide access to the in-water bridge pier.
- A smaller crane located on the US 2 side of the river will drive sheet piles to separate the Winooski River from the work zone.

No lane closures are planned as work will occur outside of the roadway. There may be brief, intermittent interruptions to traffic as trucks enter and exit the work site. Motorists are advised that the speed limit is 25 m.p.h. and speeding through a construction zone can lead to increased fines.
