

Next week will be a shorter work week for the contractor for the VT 14 Bridge Project, CCS Constructors, INC. The work site will close at Friday noon for the Memorial Day weekend. Work will resume on Tuesday, May 29.

Work schedule for the coming week (May 29-June 1) includes:

- Continue drilling shafts on Pier #2 (US 2 side of the river)
- Pour concrete for one of the drilled shafts later in the week
- Form and pour an 11-foot section of the upper part of Pier #1 (VT 14 side of the river)

Traffic impacts for next week...

There may be brief, intermittent interruptions to traffic as trucks enter and exit the work site. Please watch out for flaggers and **EXERCISE CAUTION WHILE TRAVELING THROUGH THE WORK ZONE.**

Motorists are advised that the speed limit is 25 m.p.h. and speeding through a construction zone can lead to increased fines.
