

The contractor for the VT 14 Bridge Project, CCS Constructors, INC continues to work on building foundational sections of the new bridge. Next week the contractor will:

- Pour the last shaft for Pier #2 on the US 2 side of the Winooski River
- Continue slope stabilization around Abutment #1 on the VT 14 side of the river
- Grout the newly installed Pier # 1 pier cap
- Pour the last section of wingwall for Abutment #1

Traffic impacts for next week...

- There will be one-lane travel on US 2 during non-peak hours either Tuesday afternoon (June 26) or Wednesday morning (June 27) when concrete is poured for the last shaft.
- There may be brief, intermittent interruptions to traffic as trucks enter and exit the work site all week.

Please watch out for flaggers and **EXERCISE CAUTION WHILE TRAVELING THROUGH THE WORK ZONE.**

Motorists are advised that the speed limit is 25 m.p.h. and speeding through a construction zone can lead to increased fines.
