

Construction Update VT 14 Bridge Project E MONTPELIER – Week of July 30-August 3

Next week (July 30-August 3) the contractor, CCS Constructors, INC, will continue to work on building the substructure of the new VT14 bridge over the Winooski River in E Montpelier village. Work activity will be on the Route 2 side of construction area. The contractor will:

- Form and pour a section of Abutment #2
- Begin backfilling
- Begin construction of a crane pad

Traffic impacts for next week...

- There will be alternating one way traffic on Tuesday & Wednesday during non-peak hours (9 AM - 3 PM) while concrete is poured
- One lane traffic is also possible during non-peak hours at the end of the week for the construction of a crane pad
- Motorists should expect brief, intermittent interruptions as trucks enter and exit the work site to deliver materials and equipment.

Please watch out for flaggers and **EXERCISE CAUTION WHILE TRAVELING THROUGH THE WORK ZONE.**

Motorists are advised that the speed limit is 25 m.p.h. and speeding through a construction zone can lead to increased fines.

Coming up...VT 14 will be CLOSED to all traffic AUGUST 8-10. Closure will be day and night.



Steel beams for the new bridge, now stored next to Hope Cemetery in Barre, will be erected August 8-10.
