

VT 14 E Montpelier Bridge Project Construction Update week of September 4-7

The VT 14 temporary bridge is OPEN to traffic. No more road closures are planned.

Next week (Sept 4-7) the contractor will continue constructing the bridge deck. Work activity will include:

- Pouring concrete into the bridge deck joints
- Installing rebar and forming backwalls for both bridge abutments

Traffic impacts:

- Motorists on US Route 2 and VT Route 14 should expect brief, intermittent interruptions as concrete trucks enter and exit the work area.
- The work site will be closed for Labor Day weekend, re-opening on Tuesday, August 4.

Please watch out for flaggers and **EXERCISE CAUTION WHILE TRAVELING THROUGH THE WORK ZONE.**

Motorists are advised that the speed limit is 25 m.p.h. and speeding through a construction zone can lead to increased fines.

It is illegal in VT to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.
