

E Montpelier VT 14 Bridge will be demolished next week

Next week (April 9-13) CCS Constructors, INC, will demolish and remove the concrete VT14 bridge that has spanned the Winooski River in E Montpelier village for 82 years.

Construction crews will use sawcutters and jackhammers to break up the concrete and steel deck and will haul the debris off site. Motorists should watch out trucks and equipment in the work zone and proceed with caution.

Flaggers will guide traffic on US 2 and VT 14 as trucks move in and out of the work area. No lane closures are planned. Motorists are advised that the speed limit is 25 m.p.h. and speeding through a construction zone can lead to increased fines.
