



Vermont Route 14 Bridge Replacement Project  
May 16, 2019

The Vermont Agency of Transportation will continue work on the Vermont Route 14 Bridge Project in E Montpelier village next week (May 20 - May 24). The contractor, CCS Constructors, Inc., will:

- Finish installation of new curb and new sidewalk.
- Complete installation of a sand filter on the south side of the bridge to collect and filter run off from Route 14 before discharging water into the Winooski River.
- Continue site restoration work by planting grass seed and installing mulch and grubbing (tree roots/stumps). Grubbing materials will be placed along the riverbank to minimize erosion.
- Install curb at Evergreen Lane and repair/regrade topsoil behind the retaining wall

**Coming up...**

Starting next week there will be an unrelated construction project on Route 2 east of the bridge. Beginning Monday, May 20th, contractor J. Hutchins will install construction signage and erosion control. Flaggers will be used as needed. Starting May 28th, Route 2 will be reduced to one lane from 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM for three consecutive nights to install a new precast box culvert. There will also be a lane restriction of 11 feet during the lane closure.

**Traffic impacts**

When contractors work on the Route 2 shoulder there will be one-lane travel during non-peak hours, 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Flaggers will assist motorists through the work zone. Otherwise lane reductions will be intermittent during the rest of the week. **Please exercise caution and observe the 25 mph speed limit** while driving through the work zone.
