

VT 14 E Montpelier Bridge Project Construction Update week of OCT 29 – NOV 2

Next week (OCT 29 – NOV 2) the contractor, CCS Constructors, Inc., will work on final tasks that must be completed in advance of an early November opening of the new VT14 bridge in E Montpelier village. Next week the contractor will:

- Finish installation of guardrail
- Strip forms from the bridge
- Spray water repellent on concrete sidewalks
- Install striping to newly laid roadway and bridge pavement
- Site cleanup
- Complete paving if unable to do it on Friday (NOV 26) due to weather

Traffic impacts:

- Motorists on US Route 2 and VT Route 14 should expect short, intermittent delays and one-lane travel as trucks enter and exit the work site
- There will be one-lane alternating traffic while the contractor paints lines on new pavement.

Please watch out for flaggers and **EXERCISE CAUTION WHILE TRAVELING THROUGH THE WORK ZONE.**

Motorists are advised that the speed limit is 25 m.p.h. and speeding through a construction zone can lead to increased fines.

It is illegal in VT to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a construction zone.
