



## Vermont Route 14 Bridge Replacement Project

April 26, 2019

Work on the Vermont Agency of Transportation's Vermont Route 14 Bridge Project in E Montpelier village resumed this week. It will take a couple of months for the contractor, CCS, Inc., to complete the project. Next week (April 29 - May 3) the contractor will:

- Install a light pole on US Route 2 at the intersection of VT 14
- Begin installation of a sand filter on the south side of the bridge to collect and filter run off from Route 14 before discharging water into the Winooski River – **MONDAY** only
- Install about 100 feet of new curb from the edge of the bridge extending North along the south side of Route 2 (in the area where the temporary bridge and construction equipment was located).
- Remove the guardrail along US 2 east bound and replace with temporary concrete barrier to allow the contractor to excavate and replace the existing shoulder material with new crushed gravel. **TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY**

### Traffic impacts

When the contractor works on the Route 2 shoulder (Tuesday & Wednesday) there will be one-lane travel during non-peak hours, 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Otherwise lane reductions will be intermittent during the rest of the week. **Please exercise caution and observe the 25 mph speed limit** while driving through the work zone.

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
